

FEED BACK REPORT OF COLLEGE STUDENTS 2018-19

300 Student filled their feed back form and report is following –

1. 60 percent students reported that the academic content of the syllabus was very excellent while 25 percent students reported goods. UG. Students were more satisfied with academic content than PG students.
2. 50 percent students reported excellent about usefulness of teaching material while 30 percent students reported it good.
3. About 70 percent students were in favour of punctuality in classes.
4. 40 percent students believed on fairness of evaluation by University.
5. 50 percent students interacted with faculty members.
6. 40 percent students were involved in interaction with administration.
7. After completion of their studies from this College most of UG students need to continue while PG students want to try for job.
8. The available facilities of library is excellent reported by 40 percent students while 25 percent reported good.
9. Computer facilities did not attracted the students and 30 percent students were not satisfied with the computer facilities.
10. Placement related activities should be improved because 25 percent students were not satisfied with the placement cell.
11. Less number of students participated in extra curricular activities. But participants reported excellent and good about extra curricular activities.
12. The sports facilities in the College were available and 40 percent students reported excellent and 30 percent reported good.

13. The students opinion was positive about laboratory facilities. 45 percent students were reported excellent while 40 percent reported good laboratory facilities.
14. 38 percent students were satisfied about ICT based facilities.
15. Most of agriculture students liked field visits and reported excellent to good visit experience.
16. The opinion was excellent about the campus and N.S.S.
17. The students opinion were different about valuability of subjects but all students were of same opinion that valuable subjects were good for competitive exams.
18. UG Agriculture students want spices, plantation crop and mushroom to be included in Horticulture department.
19. Expectation of 70 percent students were adequately completed in the departments.
20. Some students made lasting relationship by Dr. Kavita Srivastava & Dr. Archana Sinha.
21. 80 percent students want to continue relationship with the department after completion of their degree courses while 6 percent were not in favour of relationship. Other not gave any opinion.
22. About 20 percent students interacted with College administration while others did not gave their opinion.
23. Opinion of 80 percent students was positive about the social and teaching atmosphere of the College.
24. About 20 percent students participated in sports and extra curricular activity and they were fully satisfied.
25. About 10 percent students want to join Alumni Association of the College while 20 percent refused. Others did not gave their opinion.

26. Students were in favour to improve the College through making healthy Social atmosphere, by giving good suggestion to new students and by making good relationship to teachers as well as staff members.
27. Students have complaint about shortage in teaching staff, not co-operative fourth class staff and dirtiness of class rooms.
28. Students want to include a new course i.e. fruit and vegetable breeding in Horticulture syllabus.
29. Students were in favour of more practical classes and more field work.
30. M.Sc. Students complained about irregular Lectures in Classes.
31. At last students suggests to develop and modernize the College library.
